

# U.S. Intern Relocation Make Your Move Easier Relocation Resources.

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# Introduction

Chevron may eliminate, add or modify any relocation feature at any time without reissuing this guide or notifying employees who have been given this guide.
Welcome	Congratulations on accepting an internship at Chevron. It is Chevron's goal to make your relocation to your internship as smooth as possible.
	To facilitate your relocation to your internship location, we have developed this Intern Relocation program guide. Please take the time to read through this information so that you understand the benefits for which you are eligible and the actions for which you are responsible. An understanding of the program, along with careful planning on your part, will contribute to making your relocation a successful one.
Program Intent	The U.S. Intern Relocation program is designed to assist you with some of the major expenses and housing needs related to your internship.
Eligibility	The provisions of the U.S. Intern Relocation program apply to an employee who is offered an internship at Chevron within the United States.
Relocation Service Provider	Chevron has contracted with SIRVA BGRS to administer the Intern Relocation program. SIRVA BGRS is referred to throughout this guide as the relocation service provider. Their contact information is as follows:

Getting Started	This Intern Relocation program guide provides an overview of the U.S. Intern Relocation program.
	Read through the material in this guide carefully, so you are familiar with the relocation assistance available to you. Even if you have moved with the company before, benefits or processes may have changed. Many benefits of the U.S. Intern Relocation program are time sensitive. If you act before reading, you may jeopardize your eligibility for those benefits.
Initiating Your Relocation	Your relocation can only be initiated after you have cleared the pre-employment contingencies outlined in your offer letter. Once you have cleared, you will receive an email with instructions on how to initiate your relocation request with SIRVA BGRS. Your request will be sent to Human Resources for approval. Within 24 hours of receiving Human Resources approval, your SIRVA BGRS relocation consultant will contact you. Your relocation consultant is your point of contact during your relocation.
Your Home Address	Your home address must be the same in Workday and SIRVA BGRS' ReloAccess system. Failure to use the same primary address in both systems may result in a discrepancy between the tax gross-up that you are provided and the taxes that are withheld from your paycheck.

### **Intern Relocation Program Benefits**

As a Chevron intern, you will receive a lump-sum payment to assist you with miscellaneous expenses and travel to and from your internship location. The payment is a lump-sum allowance and it is not necessary to submit receipts for any expenses incurred. This payment is referred to as your Relocation Allowance and comprises the following benefits:

#### Miscellaneous Expense Allowance

- You will receive a one-time payment of \$300.
- Your Miscellaneous Expense Allowance is intended to assist with internship-related expenses not covered elsewhere in this policy.

#### Travel/Mileage

- Mileage to and from your Chevron internship location will be reimbursed based on the most direct driving distance from your college or home location, whichever is farther, at the current IRS mileage reimbursement rate.
- If neither your home nor your school location is greater than 50 miles from your internship work location, then you will not be reimbursed for your mileage at the beginning and end of your internship.
- You are expected to drive your personal vehicle to your Chevron internship location. If you do not have a vehicle, you will still be provided mileage-based reimbursement and can travel via an alternative mode of transportation. However, Chevron will not provide transportation for you during your internship.
- If you are an intern hired from a location outside of the United States, in lieu of mileage reimbursement, you will be reimbursed for a 21-day advance economy airfare roundtrip ticket. Please contact your SIRVA BGRS relocation consultant prior to booking your travel arrangements.

#### **Payment of Relocation Allowance**

You will receive a lump-sum payment based on the benefits as outlined below. This payment can be processed in one of two ways:

- In your first payroll after your effective start date, or
- You may request that SIRVA BGRS issue funds directly into your bank account up to 30 days prior to your effective start date.

After receiving your lump sum, if your internship is postponed, cancelled, you fail to report for your assignment as agreed or you terminate your internship prior to the expected completion, you must repay Chevron the full amount of your intern relocation payment, including any interest charges that have been incurred by Chevron.

## **Intern Housing**

Chevron's preferred intern program corporate housing partner will assign you a fully furnished corporate apartment. Applicable costs will be direct billed to Chevron, including deposit, rent, furniture, parking fees (where required), and utilities (internet, cable, electricity, water). Premium cable channels, pay-per-view movies, intern-related incidentals, and any property damage caused by the intern will be the responsibility of the intern. Prior to move-in, you will be required to provide a credit card to cover these costs.

Interns will be able to select potential roommates via RoomSync. All undergraduate interns will be assigned to a two-bedroom, two-bathroom apartment with a roommate of the same gender. Graduate and doctoral candidate interns, and interns that are married and accompanied by their spouse, will be placed in a one-bedroom, one-bathroom apartment. You must be actively enrolled and attending graduate or doctoral courses at the time of your internship to be placed in a one-bedroom, one-bathroom apartment.

#### **Taxes**

Your Intern Relocation Allowance and Intern Housing are taxable income. Chevron will tax assist all benefits for Federal taxes (including Social Security and Medicare), as well as home and work location state taxes where applicable.

**Note:** Tax assistance is provided based on federal and state supplemental tax rates.

If you elect to receive an advance of your Intern Relocation Allowance up to 30 days prior to your payroll-transfer date, an estimate of your tax withholding will be made. Final adjustments will occur when the data is transmitted to payroll.
