prepare for an event



Download the CEEL app to your mobile device.

New for 2018, with the CEEL app, you may not need to connect to CEEL through the Chevron Virtual Private Network (VPN).

- **Android-based** device (HTC, Samsung, LG): Go to the **Google Play store**, use the search keyword "CEEL". Download the app and follow the instructions to register.
- **Apple iOS device** (iPhone, iPad): Go to the **Internal Chevron App store**, use the search keyword "CEEL". Download and follow the instructions to register. At this time, the CEEL mobile app is currently not available on your *personal* Apple iOS device through any stores (such as Apple). The CEEL app is *only* available if you have a device that has been issued and is managed by Chevron, or you have a personal Apple iOS device and have "opted-in" for it to be managed by Chevron.



Save the CEEL website address hr.chevron.com/ceel

You'll need to connect to the Chevron network through VPN to access the CEEL website.

- Add CEEL to your list of **favorite websites**.
- Set CEEL as one of your links on **Inside Chevron**.



Save the Chevron Employee Emergency Line (CEEL) number in your phone contacts.

update your emergency information

Update your emergency information in the **Before an Event** section of CEEL.

Chevron may use this information to locate you and provide support following a major disaster.

- Review your personal information, such as street address and emergency telephone number.
- Optionally provide additional information that could be useful to direct HR services to you after an event.

Update your emergency contact information with HR systems.

- From **My HR – Employee Services** on the U.S. HR website, select **Personal Profile** under **Personal Information** to update your emergency contact information.

Update your emergency notification information in WhitePages.

- If you update your emergency notification information in **WhitePages**, you can receive facility alerts in the event of an emergency.

after an event

When you are in a safe place, report your status by **one** of the methods below.

You only need to report your status one time.

- Use the **CEEL mobile app**.
- If you have Chevron network access, use the **After an Event** section of the **CEEL website**.
- Call CEEL at **1-800-334-3963**.
