## how to enroll for chevron employee benefits

## before you begin, check your SSN

Your social security number (SSN) is required to create your employee record and activate your enrollment event in the benefits enrollment system, BenefitConnect, and at the HR Service Center. Due to certain security limitations in Workday, Chevron's HR system, you may be required to enter your SSN before you can make your benefit enrollment elections. Starting 9 a.m. Eastern time on January 1, 2024, follow these instructions to verify or enter your SSN in Workday. Note that you may need to have a copy of your social security card or any ID indicating your SSN to complete this task.

After you have entered your SSN in Workday, the **BenefitConnect** website will be available **the next day** for you to make 2024 health and protection benefit enrollment elections. This website is available even if you don't have access to a a company computer or kiosk. You can log in to BenefitConnect from any personal computer or mobile device with an Internet connection. ## complete dependent verification process within 60-days

As a reminder, you are required to verify the eligibility of dependents you enroll in Chevron health plans. You have up to 60 days to obtain and submit requested documentation that verifies your dependent(s) are eligible to participate in Chevron's health benefits. If you don't provide acceptable documentation by the deadline, your dependent(s) will be disenrolled from coverage. You don't need to provide your documents at the time of enrollment, but you'll need to return to the BenefitConnect website prior to your 60-day deadline to upload your documents.
