When you enroll in any Chevron medical plan, your plan automatically includes basic vision coverage at no additional premium cost or payroll deduction. Basic vision coverage generally includes a well vision exam (preventive care) and discounts on lenses, frames and contacts.

- If you enroll in the Chevron Medical PPO Plan, the HDHP or the HDHP Basic, you're also automatically enrolled in the Chevron Vision Program for basic vision coverage with **VSP**.
- If you enroll in the Medical HMO Plan Kaiser Colorado, your coverage also includes basic vision coverage through **Kaiser**.

This coverage is most like your PDC Energy Vision Plan. The **Chevron Vision Plus Program** with **VSP** provides other essential vision coverage in addition to a well vision exam *plus* expanded coverage for contacts and prescription eyewear.
